FLYING COSTS

Minimum Flying Time required for PPL - 45 hours flying time

OTHER COSTS

CFS Student Pooleys study pack. This includes all the books and study materials needed for you to learn to fly with the exception of headsets. These are provided by the school. 250

Touch and Go's. You will need to carry out a number of touch and go's whilst you learn to land and to practice different types of landings. All full stop landings are included in the hourly price but touch and go's are charged at £8 per touch and go. We would expect that you would need 20 or so touch and go's during your training. 160

Landing away at other airfields. The landing fees at other airfields will vary, but typically you can expect to pay in the region of £10-£15 per landing. There are likely to be about 7 landings during the course which will cost: 90
